



What is GMX?

That's the question. The answer is **Geek. Media. Expo.**

GMX is a multi-fandom event entering its second year and is **currently accepting advertising, exhibiting and programming requests** for the October 22-24, 2010 event! Based in Nashville, TN, GMX brings to the mid-South region. GMX is run by MTAC, the same group that has brought the eponymous convention to Middle Tennessee for over a decade.

The first GMX (or volume one) saw an attendance of over 560 individuals over the October 2-4, 2009 weekend. In the spacious Radisson Opryland atrium hotel, members mingled with fan-favorite guests like Marilyn Ghigliotti (Veronica from *Clerks*), Larry Landsman (former SCI-FI Channel special projects director), Doug Walker ("That Guy with the Glasses"), the WhatTheCast podcast and Terrance Zdunich (co-creator and Grave Robber from *REPO! The Genetic Opera*). Over 90 events and panels spanned 14 channels of content, from sci-fi to fantasy, comics to cartoons, books to movies and beyond, Plus, with the help of the attendees participating in the Movie Memorabilia Auction and the Orion Slave Auction, GMX raised over \$500 for St. Jude's and the Comic Book Legal Defense Fund.

GMX Vol. 2 is shaping up to be another fun-filled 48 Hours of Cool™. The programming is upping the ante by expanding to 18 channels of content, including the new CHRON (Alternate Timeline) and NOCT (Nocturnal Tales) Channels. Some of the newest events are the Chara-Chabaret, Friday Night '80s Dance, Hogwarts High Tea, *Repo* Shadowcast with Testify and this year's masquerade - the Clockwork Cotillion. This year's guest roster adds Aaron Douglas (star of *Battlestar Galactica*), James O'Barr (creator of *The Crow*), Jeph Jacques (writer/artist of the webcomic *Questionable Content*), April Hunter and J.D. Michaels (professional wrestlers), and Apparition Abolishers (costumers, artists, prop-makers and performers).

GMX Vol. 2 returns to the Radisson Opryland on October 22-24, 2010. If you have any bit of geekiness, nerdiness or obsessive fandom compulsions, then GMX is the place for you. However you wish to participate, GMX has ample methods for you:
